# Information for applicants

## About the application form

The form has two sides. The first side asks for personal information. The second side asks for information about the decision that you want reviewed. Please fill in both sides. The Tribunal needs this information to process your application. If there is not enough space in a box provided in the form, write in the box 'see attached' and write your additional information on a separate piece of paper then attach it to the form. If you have to do this more than once, use headings on the separate piece of paper to show which question is being answered.

## Fees

There is no fee for a reconsideration application to the Tribunal.

## Your application details

If you can, attach a copy of the decision you want the Tribunal to reconsider to this form. If you can't, please complete the questions to enable the relevant decision to be quickly identified.

## Reasons for seeking reconsideration

It is a requirement of the Native Title Act that you state the basis on which you are seeking reconsideration of the decision. Please provide as much information as possible about why you want the claim in your application reconsidered, explaining:

- which sections of the decision you disagree with and why
- whether there is information you think that should or should not have been taken into account when the decision was made
- if there is any other aspect of the decision-making process that you would like to draw the member's attention to.

## Federal Court review

If you have applied to the Federal Court for a review of the decision made by the Registrar

or the Registrar's delegate you cannot seek a reconsideration of the claim by the NNTT.

## Privacy

We will use the information you provide to process your application to reconsider the claim made in your native title determination application. Section 190E authorises the National Native Title Tribunal (the Tribunal) to collect information for the purposes of reconsideration of claims. We will disclose the information you give us to the relevant state or territory government and any other third party to whom procedural fairness is owed. Section 190A(3) authorises the Registrar and, in cases of reconsideration, the Tribunal to have regard to the information you provide in relation to the reapplication of the registration test should you amend your claim in the future, and the registration of other claims where appropriate.

The decision on the outcome of the reconsideration application, including any written reasons for the decision, will also be published on the Tribunal's website [www.nntt.gov.au](http://www.nntt.gov.au) and perhaps in the Federal Law Reports. If there is a challenge to a decision by the Tribunal or a request under another law of the Commonwealth, we may need to disclose your information to a court or to another Commonwealth agency or other persons as required or authorised by law.

## Return of documents

Original documents containing additional information may be returned if, at the time you provide the documents, you advise in writing that you wish the documents to be returned.
