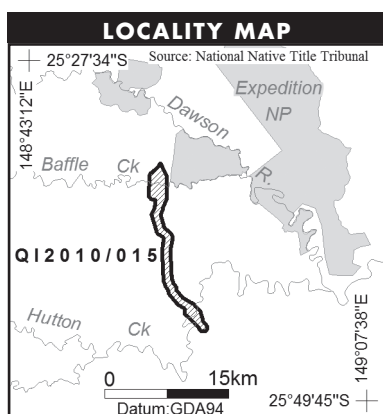

The Bidjara Native Title Applicants and the Bidjara Native Title Claim Group:

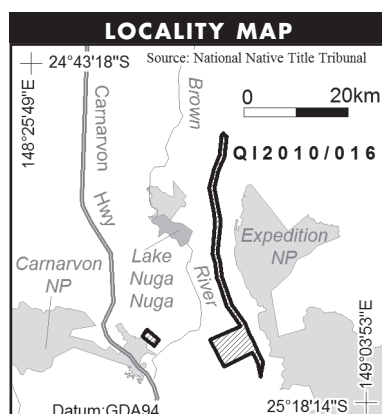
- consent to the use of the Pipeline Land for the construction, operation, use, maintenance, repair, further development, decommissioning and rehabilitation of the Pipeline; and

#### Clause 3.7 Consent to Future Acts

The Parties consent, for the purposes of section 24EB(1)(b) of the NTA and regulation 7(5) of the *Native Title (Indigenous Land Use Agreement) Regulations 1999* (Cth), to the doing of any of the acts referred to in this clause 3 that are Future Acts.

#### 3.8 Acts excluded from the right to negotiate

Subdivision P, division 3 of part 2 of the NTA is not intended to apply and does not apply to the Future Acts authorised by this Agreement.

### Objections to the registration of an ILUA where the application for registration has been certified

These two applications for registration of indigenous land use agreements (ILUAs) have been certified by Queensland South Native Title Services Limited, the representative body for the areas concerned. The area covered by each agreement is shown on the respective maps in this notice. Any person claiming to hold native title to any part of the areas covered by either agreement may object in writing within the notice period to the registration of the agreements if they think that the applications to register the ILUAs have not been properly certified.

If you wish to object to the registration of any of the agreements (and you hold or claim to hold native title in any part of the areas covered by the agreements) you may only object for one reason: in your view, the applications to register the ILUAs have not been properly certified, as stated in section 203BE(5)(a) and (b) of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cwlth).

You must make this objection in writing and send it to the **Native Title Registrar, National Native Title Tribunal, GPO Box 9973, Brisbane QLD 4001 by 11 November 2010.**

Generally procedural fairness will require that the material you provide is given to certain other persons or organisations for comment. It may also be taken into account in the registration of other ILUAs and claimant applications and thus be provided to relevant persons or organisations for comment.
