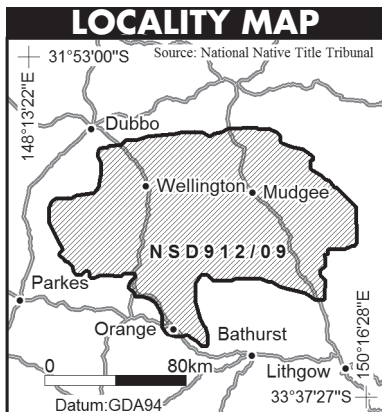

This is an application by a native title claim group who are asking the Federal Court to determine that the group hold native title in the area described below.

A person who wants to become a party to this application must write to the **Registrar of the Federal Court, Level 17, Law Courts Building, Queens Square, SYDNEY, NSW 2000**, on or before **29 September 2010**. After **29 September 2010**, the Federal Court's permission to become a party is required.

Under the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cwlth) there can be only one determination of native title for a particular area. If a person with native title rights and interests does not become a party to this application, there may be no other opportunity for the Federal Court, in making its determination, to take into account those native title rights and interests in relation to the area concerned.

Registration test status: The Native Title Registrar has *accepted* this application for registration.

Description of the application area: The external boundary of this application covers the towns of Orange, Wellington and Mudgee, and is located north of Bathurst, south of Dubbo and east of Parkes. Not all land within the external boundary is claimed, for example freehold land is excluded.

This application falls within the Local Government Authorities of Mid-Western Regional Council, City of Lithgow, Bathurst Regional Council, Orange City Council, Cabonne Shire Council, Dubbo City Council, Parkes Shire Council, Wellington Council, Warrumbungle Shire Council and Narromine Shire Council.
