



SCHEDULE A: NATIVE TITLE CLAIM GROUP

The names of the persons (the native title claim group) on whose behalf the application is made or a sufficiently clear description of the persons so that it can be ascertained whether any particular person is one of those people.

1. The native title claim group in relation to the area claimed is comprised of the Primary Native Title Holders and Other Native Title Holders who, in accordance with traditional laws and customs have a communal native title in the application area, from which rights and interests derive.
2. The Primary Native Title Holders are members of three estate groups, namely the Burdal Riley, Murrungun Wunubari and Mambali Walangara estate groups, who, in accordance with traditional laws and customs, are traditionally connected with the area described in schedule B ("the area claimed") by reason of:
 - (a) patrilineal descent;
 - (b) his or her mother, father's mother or mother's mother being or having been a member of the group by reason of patrilineal descent; or
 - (c) having been adopted or incorporated into the descent relationships referred to in (i) or (ii) hereof.
3. By definition the Burdal Riley estate group is comprised of all the descendants of three apical persons being the late Wulwanggu, Ruluju and an unnamed Aboriginal man.
4. By definition the Murrungun Wunubari estate group is comprised of all the descendants of five apical persons being the late Janggawuma, George Marindilama, Gabarunguna, Long Jack Majala and an unnamed Aboriginal man.
5. By definition the Mambali (Walangara) estate group is comprised of all the descendants of two apical persons being the late Wuwandaya and an unnamed Aboriginal man.
6. The descendants from Wulwanggu include:
 - (a) Niyundiyege (deceased), who was an Aboriginal man who had the children George Riley Marlindja, Mac Riley Manguji, William Riley Nambayala and Tom Riley



Nawurrungu (all deceased).

7. The descendants from Ruluju (deceased) include:
 - (a) Larry Riley Buruwulanji (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the children Paddy Riley Wurrandan, Ginger Riley Munduwalawala, Robert Riley Manjayu, Roy Hammer Gundunguwu and William Riley Jarbulangayi (all deceased).

8. The descendants from the unnamed Burdal Aboriginal man include:
 - (a) Barragaga (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man and who had the children Cyril Burranda and Sandy August (both deceased).

9. The descendants from Janggawuma include:
 - (a) Clara (deceased), who was an Aboriginal woman who had the children Harriet Mambuwarra, Simon Bawujiminja, Dima, Damburru and Juri (all deceased);
 - (b) John Forrest Bunuji (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the children Elsie Manbilyungu, Queenie Riley Nambarruludi, Freda John Forrest Miramba, Tex John Forrest Walayanggayangga (all deceased) and Gordon Forrest Nawundulpi.

10. The descendants from the unnamed Murrungun Aboriginal man include:
 - (a) Mirrimirrin (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had a son Albert Lindarrangu (deceased);
 - (b) Wangiwangi (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had the children Joshua Ambirring and Isaac Joshua Loburr (both deceased).

11. The descendants from George Marindilama include:
 - (a) Gulumba (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the children Stanley Mabungu, Andai Mawurranja and Nora Walingandu (all deceased);
 - (b) Windjimalgu (deceased), who was an Aboriginal woman who had no children;
 - (c) Harry Limmen (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the children Sammy, Gerald, Marie and Noel Limmen (all deceased) and Mavis, Julie and Nelson Limmen.

12. The descendants from Gabarunguna include:



- (a) Jack Baju (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the children Jemima, Musso Harvey Bunggarinu, Isaac Yuwalinji, Elsie Maljinbangu, Douglas Wadaba, Andrea Mulholland and Mulgin Malcolm (all deceased).
13. The descendants from Long Jack Majala include:
- (a) Rosalyn Roberts Mawurarila (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had a daughter Jennifer Roberts;
- (b) Edna Pluto Maliyawuna (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had the children Timothy and Bob Pluto (both deceased), Ivan, Douglas, John, Dixie and Patsy Pluto;
- (c) Malcolm (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;
- (d) Eileen Milbirriya (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had no children.
14. The descendants from Wuwandaya include:
- (a) Ganjirruala (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Joe Yabumana and Peter Ngarrawu (both deceased), Topsy Mindirriju, Fanny Yilayi and Henry Jurluba;
- (b) Mawurlu (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had a daughter Bessie Wunyuga (deceased);
- (c) Jujuju Gurrunangul (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had a son Barney Marrambamu (deceased);
- (d) Wurranduwa (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the children Roger Rogers Ganbubuk, Queenie Simon Anjarlarla and Rosie Yungamanji (all deceased).
15. The descendants from the unnamed Mambali Aboriginal man include:
- (a) Guywiarru (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man ~~who had a son Daniel Guralduwa (deceased);~~
- (b) Kitty Gunjurli (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had the children Girly Limmen and Bruce Limmen (both deceased);
- (c) Bilbajarminy (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had the daughter Maliyawuru Jilriba (deceased).
16. The Other Native Title Holders are, in accordance with traditional laws and customs, other people who have rights and interests in respect of the area claimed, subject to the rights and interests of the Primary Native Title Holders, such people being:
- (d) members of estate groups from neighbouring estates; and
- (e) spouses of the estate group members.
