The application is made on behalf of the Barada Barna People being the descendants of the following apical ancestors:

- 7. Polly (wife of Thomas Mitchell)
- 8. Lucy Ross
- 9. Laura (wife of Duke/George Barker, Needy/Teddy Sauney and Adam Bowen) and
- 10. Charles Budby (father of George "Salt Bush" Budby.

Native title rights and interests claimed:

- 1. The Applicant acknowledges that, in relation that part of the application area which at the time of filing this Further Amended Native Title Determination Application is also the subject of a native title determination application in proceedings QUD 492 of 2013 ("the Widi #2 Application"), rights and interests are held by the Barada Barna People as well as by the claimant group described in the Widi #2 Application. The Applicant does not oppose recognition of the co-existence of the native title rights and interests claimed in the Widi #2 Application.
- 2. The nature and extent of the native title rights and interests claimed in relation to land and waters are the non-exclusive rights to:
- 1. access, be present on, move about on and travel over the application area;
- camp, and live temporarily on the application area as part of camping, and for that purpose build temporary shelters:
- 3. hunt, fish and gather on the land and waters of the application area for personal, domestic and non-commercial communal purposes;
- 4. take, use, share and exchange Natural Resources from the land and waters of the area for personal, domestic and non-commercial communal purposes;
- 5. take and use the Water of teh application area for personal, domestic and non-commercial communal purposes;
- 6. conduct ceremonies on the application area;
- 7. be buried and bury native title holders within the application area;
- 8. maintain within the application area places of importance and areas of significance to the native title holders under their traditional laws and customs and protect those places and areas from physical harm;
- 9. teach on the application area the physical and spiritual attributes of the application area;
- 10. hold meetings on the application area; and
- 11. light fires on the area for domestic purposes including cooking, but not for the purpose of hunting or clearing vegetation.

- d) an exclusive agricultural lease or an exclusive pastoral lease;
- e) a residential lease;
- f) a community purpose lease;
- g) a lease dissected from a mining lease and referred to in s.23B(2)(c)(vii) of the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth);
- h) any lease (other than a mining lease) that confers a right of exclusive possession over particular land or waters.
- 3. Subject to paragraphs 4, the area covered by the application excludes any land or waters covered by the valid construction or establishment of any public work, where the construction [or] establishment of the public work commenced on or before 23 December 1996.
- 4. Where the act specified in paragraphs 2 and 3 falls within the provisions of:
- a) s.23B(9) Exclusion of acts benefiting Aboriginal Peoples or Torres Strait Islanders;
- b) s.23B(9A) Establishment of a national park or state park;
- c) s.23B(9B) Acts where legislation provides for non-extinguishment;
- d) s.23C(9C) Exclusion of Crown to Crown grants; or
- e) s.23B(10) Exclusion by regulation
