# QUD504/2011 Kooma People #4 (QC2011/007)

This description is an interpretation of the area that remains as a result of:

The Consent Determination of native title for QUD504/2011 Kooma People #4 (QCD2014/012) as determined in the Federal Court on 25 June 2014.

## External boundary description

The application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at a point on the eastern bank of the Culgoa River at Longitude 148.247688° East, also a south eastern corner of native title determination QUD504/2011 Kooma People #4 Part A (QCD2014/012), and extending generally south easterly and generally south westerly passing through the following points:

Then south westerly to a point on the Queensland/New South Wales border at Longitude 148.231533° East; then westerly along that border to its intersection with the eastern bank of the Culgoa River; the generally north easterly along the eastern bank of that river (also part of the south eastern boundary native title determination QUD504/2011 Kooma People #4 Part A (QCD2014/012) back to the commencement point.
