### Woppaburra External Boundary Description

The application area covers with the all the land and waters within the Dharumbal Traditional Use Marine Resources Agreement (TUMRA) – Woppaburra Section described as:

Commencing a point in the South Pacific Ocean at Longitude 150.858330° East, Latitude 23.000000° South and extending east, south-easterly, again east, then south, south-westerly, west and north-westerly passing through the following coordinate points:

Then north back to the commencement point.

#### Data Reference and source

#### Reference datum
