## External boundary description

The application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at the intersection of the centreline of the Ducie River and the eastern boundary of Lot 8 on MP14466 and extending generally north westerly along the centreline of that river to its mouth at Port Musgrave; then north westerly to the southernmost point of Lot 9 on SP204113, being a point on the northern bank of the Ducie River; then generally north easterly and generally south easterly along the northern bank of that River to the eastern boundary of Lot 8 on MP14466; then southerly along the boundary of that lot back to the commencement point.
