Information identifying the boundaries of:

a) the area covered by the application; and

b) any areas within those boundaries that are not covered by the application.

### A. The area covered by the application

Except for the areas excluded under [B] below, the area covered by the Wirangu No 2 application lies within an external boundary described as follows:

The Wirangu No. 2 external boundary commencing at the point the south west corner of Section 45, Hundred of Petina (Port Lincoln – Thevenard Railway Corridor/Tod River Pipeline parcel) [being a point on the southern portion of Far West Coast Determination Area external boundary and the western portion of the Barngarla Native Title Determination Area Claim external boundary]; then south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of Section 20, Hundred of Perlubie and Section 59, Hundred of Walpuppie to the southern-most corner of the said Section 59; south-westerly along the production south-westerly of the south-eastern boundary of Section 59, Hundred of Walpuppie to its intersection with the centreline of the Eyre Highway road reserve; generally south-easterly along the centreline of the Eyre Highway road reserve; generally south-easterly along the Elliston Stock Route road reserve [being along a portion of the western portion of the Barngarla Native Title Determination Area Claim external boundary]

Then generally south-westerly along the centreline of the Elliston Stock Route road reserve to the point Longitude 135.550650 East, Latitude 33.133696 South then south-westerly to the point Longitude 135.548228 East, Latitude 33.135132 South then north-westerly to the point Longitude 135.543894 East, Latitude 33.134367 South [being a point on the centreline of the Elliston Stock Route road reserve]. Then generally south-westerly along the centreline of the Elliston Stock Route road reserve to its intersection with the centreline of the Mount Wedge Road road reserve; generally south-westerly along the centreline of the Mount Wedge Road road reserve to its intersection with the production north-westerly of the north-eastern boundary of Section 36, Hundred of Kappakoola; south-easterly along the said production to the northern- most comer of Section 36, Hundred of Kappakoola [being a north-eastern comer of Cocata Conservation Park]. Then generally south-easterly, generally southerly and westerly along the north-eastern, eastern and southern boundaries of the said Section 36 to the eastern boundary of Section 15, Hundred of Cocata; southerly and westerly along the eastern and southern boundaries of Section 15, Hundred of Cocata to the south-west comer of the said Section 15 [being along a portion of the eastern and southern boundaries of Cocata Conservation Park]. Then westerly along the production westerly of the southern boundary of Section 15, Hundred of Cocata to its intersection with the centreline of the Mount Wedge Road road reserve; generally south-westerly along the centreline of the Mount Wedge Road road reserve until it becomes the centreline of the Kyancutta-Mount Wedge Road road reserve; generally south-westerly along the centreline of the Kyancutta-Mount Wedge Road road reserve to its intersection with the centreline of the Birdseye Highway road reserve; generally south-westerly along the centreline of the Birdseye Highway road reserve to its intersection with the centreline of the Flinders Highway road reserve; south-westerly in a straight line to the point Longitude 134.896249 East, Latitude 33.659305 South and southwesterly along the production of said straight line to its intersection with Lowest Astronomical Tide [being along a portion of the north- western portion of the Nauo Native Title Claim (SAD 6021/1998) external boundary].

Then generally north-westerly along Lowest Astronomical Tide to the western-most point of Cape Bauer.

Then generally easterly and generally north-westerly along Lowest Astronomical Tide to the south-east comer of the Hundred of Wallanippie [being along a portion of the eastern portion of the Native Title Claim Far West Coast Sea Claim external boundary].

Then northerly along the eastern boundary of the Hundred of Wallanippie to the south-west

comer of the Hundred of Carawa; easterly along the southern boundaries of the Hundred Carawa and the Hundred of Petina to the point of commencement [being along a portion of the southern portion of Far West Coast Determination Area external boundary].

B. Areas within the boundaries described above that are NOT covered by the application

The Applicant excludes from the area covered by the application any land that, on the date the claim was lodged was:

- A. freehold; or
- B. held under a perpetual lease; or
- C. land within all townships-or-settlements-delineated on the Public Map held by the Registrar General.
- D. To the extent not covered by A or B above is otherwise an exclusive possession act.

For the avoidance of doubt the Applicant does not include in the claim area any land that was not covered by the Wirangu No 2 claim as lodged on 28 August 1997 and subsequently amended on 12 March 1999 and 25 January 2000.

On 8 July 2019 Justice Charlesworth made a finding of fact regarding paragraph C above, in Wilson v State of South Australia (No 3) [2019] FCA 1150 (26 July 2019).

- 18 ... I made a finding to the effect that there was no "Public Map" of a kind referred to in the paragraph C exclusion and that, as a consequence, there was no land excluded by the description within the boundaries of the claim area to which Part A relates.
- 19. It follows from that finding that the only land excluded from the Part A claim is that land meeting the descriptions in paragraph A (freehold land) and paragraph B (perpetual leasehold land) at the time that the application was first filed. The tenure analysis undertaken by the State enables that land to be readily identified.

The Applicant excludes from the claim area any parcels of land included within the Wirangu No 3 determination application filed on 28 October 2019, SAD 228/2019 as amended, specifically:
