1. The individuals who comprise the Ngadjuri People’s native title claim group are the biological descendants of the following apical ancestors:

a) Fanny, who was born at Winnininnie, and her spouse Gudjari

2. Born around 1825 and died in mid-1896. Fanny’s daughter, Emily Lamb was born at either Winnininnie Station or Yonggala Station. Emily had five children, including her son, Barney Warrior who was born at Orroroo in 1873.
3. Family names associated with this ancestor include (but are not limited to): Agius, Ashby-Agius, Abdulla, Angrave, Angie, Beig, Branson, Bridley, Bright, Brown, Buckskin, Carter, Copley, Crombie, Cunningham, Donht, Dudley, Dunnett, Edwards, Egan, Goldsmith, Graham, Harradine, Harris, Hutchens, Jackson, Karpany, Kartinyeri, Kropinyeri, Lawrie, Lindsay, Ling, Martin, Miller, Mullion, Nelson, Nettles, Newchurch, Newchurch-Papillo, Rankine, Rigney-Graham, Sansbury, Shattell, Smith, Sparrow, Sumner, Tong, Turner, Wanganeen, Warrior, Westard, Waria-Read, Webb, Weetra, Wilson, Wilton, Woodward.

b) Richard (Dick) Warrior

4. Richard Warrior was Edgar Philip Warrior’s father. Edgar Philip Warrior was born about 1880 at Spring Creek (near Melrose). Edgar married Alice Thompson who was born about 1890 at Wirrabara.
5. Family names associated with this ancestor include (but are not limited to): Bromley, Campion, Clark, Harding, Hart, Meany, Milera, Sanderson-Milera, and Warrior.

c) The un-named mother of Ned Edwards, who was born at Booyoolee, near Gladstone

6. She was born between 1820-1830 in Gladstone and was the mother of Ned Edwards. Ned Edwards was born around 1840 also at Booyoolee.
7. d) The un-named mother of the Armstrong siblings who was born at Canowie

8. An un-named woman was born around 1840 in Canowie. She had three daughters, Ellen Armstrong, Amelia Armstrong and Joanna Armstrong. Ellen Armstrong was born about 1864 at Bungaree and died on 17 July 1891 at Point McLeay. Amelia Armstrong was born between 1860 and 1865 at Canowie and died on 2 August 1893 in Adelaide. Joanna Armstrong was born around 1868 at Canowie and died on 20 May 1914 at Point McLeay.
9. e) The un-named mother of Alice Morris, who was born at Canowie

10. The un-named woman gave birth to Alice Morris between 1860-1870 at Canowie. Alice was the first wife of Crofton Giles. He was born around 1865 at Point McLeay and died in 1940 at Point Pearce.
11. Family names associated with this ancestor include (but are not limited to): Agius, Giles, Gollan, Harradine, Miller, Rigney, Scott, Taylor, Walker, Wanganeen, Weetra, Wilson.

f) The un-named mother of William John Miller and Amelia Miller

12. William John Miller was born about 1874. William's spouse was Annie Warrior. The children of William John Miller are Margaret Emily Miller and William Miller.
13. Amelia Y. Miller was born around 1864 or 1875 and she died around 1924. Amelia Miller's partner was William John Stewart (or Stuart). Amelia and William had a number of children including Emma Jane Stewart born 1885 in Hawker, and Joanna Stewart born 1889 on Bungaree Station.
14. Family names associated with this ancestor include (but are not limited to): Anderson, Childs, Durbridge, Hilzinger, Keneally, Lee, Martin, Miller, Stewart, Thomas.

g) Eliza McGrath, antecedent of the McGrath family

15. Eliza McGrath was born around 1850 and died 1 February 1921 at Point Pearce. Eliza's son, Fred McGrath, was born around 1869 at Pt Germain and died 30 March 1931 in Port Augusta.
16. Family names associated with this ancestor include (but are not limited to): Evans, Hughes, McGrath, Walker.
