WILYAKALI NATIVE TITLE CLAIM

ATTACHMENT "A"

The Wilyakali are defined by broad cognatic descent from the ancestors who owned the country surrounding Broken Hill and to the west in South Australia, in the pre-contact and early contact period, and from known, named ancestors belonging to more recent history.

The Wilyakali claim group comprises those people who hold in common the body of traditional laws and customs governing the area subject of the claim and who:

1. Are related by means of the principle of descent to:

1.1. **Jack Tyler** born in 1857 who is acknowledged as an apical ancestor for the Wilyakali native title claim. Jack married Maggie (Cate) Newton and they had two daughters, Molly and Topsy Tyler.

The following sets of siblings, the descendants of Jack Tyler, together with all their descendants, are members of the native title claim group:

- 1.1.1 Molly Tyler born c1902 and Topsy Tyler born c1907;
- 1.1.2 Ross (also known as Alf) Barlow, Jacky Dougal, Albert Bates, Hector Bates and Wilki Bates;
- 1.1.3 May Barlow, Len Barlow, Don (also known as Donny) Barlow and Doris (also known as Dori) Barlow.

1.2. **Outalpa Dick** and his wife **Mary Bone** are acknowledged as apical ancestors for the Wilyakali native title claim. Their son Outalpa George who was born c1851 and his wife Emma Beans had two children, Tottie (also known as Dottie) Teetalpa and Georgy Boy Teetalpa.

The following sets of siblings, the descendants of Outalpa Dick and Mary Bone, together with all their descendants are members of the native title claim group:

- 1.2.1. Tottie Teetalpa born c1889 and Georgy Boy Teetalpa born c1890;
- 1.2.2 Hilda (also known as Ruby) Gibson born 1910, Ethel May Gibson born 1911 and Mabel Gibson born 1913.

1.3. **Crancey** the daughter of Joe born c1871 and mother Fanny, is acknowledged as an apical ancestor for the Wilyakali native title claim. Crancey and her husband Frank Williams had two children Frank and Nancy.



The following sets of siblings, the descendants of Crancey, together with all their descendants are members of the native title claim group:

- 1.3.1 Frank Bates (also known as Frank Williams) born c1913 and Nancy Gibson born c1916;**
- 1.3.2 Alfred Bates, Valda Bates, Harold Bates, Maureen Bates, Kevin Bates, Colin Bates, Barbara Bates and Robert Bates.**

1.4. Minnie Williams born c1880 is acknowledged as an apical ancestor for the Wilyakall native title claim.
