ARABANA NO. 2 NATIVE TITLE CLAIM

Technical Description: Arabana People Native Title Claim

The application area consists of two parts and covers all the lands and waters within the external boundaries described below:

Part 1 - External Boundary

Commencing at a point of the western boundary of native title determination SAD6017/98 Dieri Native Title Claim (SC97/4) at Longitude 138.128406° East, Latitude 29.693668° South and extending south westerly along that native title determination boundary to the centreline of the Frome River at Latitude 29.712754° South; then generally south easterly along that centreline, also a boundary of that determination to it's intersection with a line joining Longitude 138.442894° East, Latitude 29.777290° South and Longitude 138.250455° East, Latitude 29.844403° South, being a point on the northern boundary of native title determination SAD6001/98 Adnyamathanha No.1 (SC99/1); then generally south westerly along that native title determination boundary, passing through the following coordinate points.

Then again south westerly along that native title determination boundary to Longitude 137.862798° East, Latitude 29.956059° South, being a point on the southern boundary of native title determination SAD6025/98 Arabana People (SC98/2); then generally north easterly along that native title determination boundary back to the commencement point passing through the following coordinate points.

Part 2 - External Boundary

Commencing at the south western corner of S1188 on H831300 and extending northerly and generally easterly along western and northern boundaries of that lot and S1187 on H831300 to the northern corner of S1193 H831300; then south easterly and westerly along boundaries of that lot to an eastern boundary of S1184 on H831300; then westerly, generally south westerly, again westerly, generally northerly and again westerly along the southern boundaries of that land parcel, southern boundaries of A2018 on D34373, S1192 on H831300, eastern, southern and western boundaries of S372 on H8331300, western boundary of S1192 on H831300 and the southern boundary of S1188 on H831300, back to the commencement point.

Exclusions.

This application excludes any land and waters subject to native title determinations:

- SAD6017/98 Dieri Native Title Claim (SC97/4)
- SAD6025/98 Arabana People (SC98/2)
- SAD6001/98 Adnyamathanha No.1 (Stage 1) (SC99/1)
- SAD6022/98 Yankunytjatjara Antakirinja (SC97/9)
