

## **Native Title Determination Application**

### **The Malgana Shark Bay People's Application - Remaining Area**

#### **External boundary description**

The application area is located at Wilya Mia (on Heirisson Prong) and covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of Lot 3080 on Deposited Plan 51350 (Unallocated Crown Land) at Latitude 26.065281° South (approximate Longitude 113.363669° East) and extending generally north westerly and generally north easterly along the boundaries of that lot to Longitude 113.362498° East (approximate Latitude 26.062110° South); then south easterly back to the commencement point.

- Application boundary compiled by National Native Title Tribunal based on information or instructions provided by the applicants.
- Cadastral data sourced from Landgate (WA) Spatial Cadastral Database (SCDB), August 2018.

#### **Reference datum**

Geographical coordinates have been provided by the NNTT Geospatial Services and are referenced to the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94), in decimal degrees and are based on the spatial reference data acquired from the various custodians at the time

#### **Use of Coordinates**

Where coordinates are used within the description to represent cadastral or topographical boundaries or the intersection with such, they are intended as a guide only.
