



WAD29/2019 Yugunga-Nya People (WC1999/046) (Amended)

External boundary description

The application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at the southernmost intersection of Native Title Determination WAD72/1998 Nharnuwangga (WCD2000/001) and Native Title Determination WAD6002/2003 Gingirana (WCD2017/011), being a southern boundary of Three Rivers Pastoral Lease (N049591) and extending generally north easterly, generally easterly, and southerly along the boundaries of Native Title Determination WAD6002/2003 Gingirana (WCD2017/011) to the northwesternmost intersection with Native Title Determination WAD6164/1998, WAD248/2007, WAD181/2012, WAD108/2016 Wiluna (WCD2013/004), being the eastern boundary of Neds Creek Pastoral Lease (N049751); then generally south westerly along boundaries of that native title determination to the intersection with the northernmost north western corner of Lot 329 as shown on Deposited Plan 402616, being also the intersection of the southern boundary of Road No. 7583 (Goldfields Highway) and an eastern boundary of Road No. 4274; then generally south westerly along the eastern boundary of Road No 4274 to Latitude 26.820668° South; then south westerly to the intersection of the eastern boundary of Road No 4274 with Latitude 26.826718° South; then generally south westerly again along the eastern boundary of Road No 4274 to Latitude 27.879005° South; then north westerly to the eastern most point on the boundary of Native Title Determination WAD6123/1998 Badimia People (WCD2015/001) at Longitude 118.941344° East, Latitude 27.878925° South; then generally north westerly along boundaries of that native title determination to the intersection with the external boundary of Native Title Determination WAD6033/1998 Wajarri Yamatji (WCD2017/007) at Longitude 117.685671° East, Latitude 27.579252° South; then generally north easterly along the external boundaries of that native title determination to Longitude 118.979625° East, Latitude 25.834935° South, being a point on the southern boundary of Native Title Determination WAD72/1998 Nharnuwangga (WCD2000/001); then generally north easterly along boundaries of that native title determination to intersect a western boundary of Lot 36 as shown on Deposited Plan 238583 at Latitude 25.832988° South; then generally north easterly passing through the following coordinate points:

Then north easterly to a point on the eastern boundary of Native Title Determination WAD72/1998 Nharnuwangga (WCD2000/001) at Longitude 119.078725° East, Latitude 25.805663° South; then



generally north easterly along boundaries of that native title determination back to the commencement point.

- Native Title Determination WAD72/1998 Nharnewangga (WCD2000/001) as determined by the Federal Court on 29 August 2000.

- Native Title Determination WAD6002/2003 Gingirana (WCD2017/011) as determined by the Federal Court on 07 December 2017.
