Additional Information

On 27 September 2017, the Federal Court of Australia made a determination that native title exists in the entire determination area – see the attached determinations: Harvey Murray and State of Western Australia & Ors (Yilka and Yilka #2) and G.S. (dec'd) & Ors and the State of Western Australia & Ors (Sullivan Family). On 26 September 2019, the Federal Court ordered that the Yilka Talintji Aboriginal Corporation ICN 8415 hold the native title on trust and perform the functions mentioned in s 57(1) of the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth), (i.e. become the registered native title body corporate for this determination). Therefore, this determination is now finalised as from 26 September 2019

Persons claiming to hold native title:

- 5. The native title claim group comprises those persons:
- (a) who have a connection to the land and waters, through:
- (i) their own birth on those lands or waters;
- (ii) their long association with those lands or waters;
- (iii) the birth and/or the long association with those lands or waters of one or more of their ancestors; or
- (iv) their holding of senior ritual authority in relation to those lands or waters,

by which those persons claim to possess rights or interests in relation to the land and waters; and

- (b) in respect of whom that claim is recognised under the laws and customs of the society generally referred to as the Western Desert Cultural Bloc (WDCB).
- 6. At the date of the application, the persons referred to in [5(a)(i)-(iii)] are:
- (a) the descendants of the Marnupa, Waltila and Nanuma, Billy Kurlu, Sandy Grey, Skipper Elliot, Charlie Winter, Danny Harris, Lincoln Smith, Paul Simms and Andrew Watson; and
- (b) Victor Fraser and his descendants.

Native title rights and interests claimed:

A description of the native title rights and interests in relation to particular land or waters (including any activities in exercise of those rights and interests).

- 13. The nature and extent of the native title rights and interests is the right of possession, occupation, use and enjoyment to the exclusion of all others.
- 14. The native title rights and interests are exercisable in accordance with and subject to the:
- (a) traditional laws and customs of the native title holders; and
- (b) laws of the State and Commonwealth, including the common law.
- 15. Notwithstanding anything in this determination, there are no native title rights and interests in the application area in or in relation to:
- (a) such minerals as are wholly owned by the Crown; or
- (b) such petroleum as is wholly owned by the Crown.

- 7. The external geographical boundaries of the area are covered by this application are:
- (a) All those lands and waters commencing from the northernmost northwestern corner of the eastern severance of Reserve 18594 and extending generally southwesterly along boundaries of that severance to a boundary of Reserve 22032; Then westerly along the boundary of that reserve to the southernmost southeastern corner of the western severance of Reserve 18594; Then generally northeasterly along boundaries of that severance to a boundary of Reserve 22032; the easterly along the boundary of that reserve back to the commencement point.
- (b) All those lands and waters being that parcel of unallocated crown land commencing at approximately Latitude 28.402278 South, Longtitude 123.268831 East and extending easterly, southwesterly and northerly through the following approximate coordinate positions back to the commencement point.

- (iv) Catergory B intermediate period acts that are wholly inconsistent with the continued existence, enjoyment or exercise of any native title rights or interests;
- (b) any area in relation to which a 'relevant act' as that term is defined in section 12I of the Titles (Validation) and Native Title (Effect of Past Acts) Act 1995 (WA) was done and the act is

attributable to the State of Western Australia;

(c) any area in relation to which a previous exclusive possession act under section 12J ot the Titles (Validation) and Native Title (Effect of Past Acts) Act 1995 (WA) was done and that act

is attributable to the State of Western Australia;

(d) any area in relation to which a previous exclusive possession act under section 23B (including section 23B (7)) of the Act was done in relation to the area and the act was attributable

to the Commonwealth; and

- (e) any areas where native title rights and interests have otherwise been wholly extinguished, including any:
- (i) public works as defined in section 253 of the Act; or
- (ii) existing dedicated public roads
