- (a) hold native title rights and interests in part or all of the application area according to traditional laws and customs, including through one or more of the following pathways:
- (i) their own birth on the application area;
- (ii) the birth of an ancestor on the application area;
- (iii) having religious, sacred or ritual authority for the application area; or
- (iv) long traditional association with the application area through occupation, custodianship or use by one's self and/or relevant kin; and
- (b) are recognised under traditional laws and customs by other members of the native title claim group as having rights and interests in part or all of the application area.
- 39. At the date of this application, the persons referred to in paragraph 38 above includes the descendants of the following persons:
- (a) Banjo Tjungarrayi;
- (b) Unamed Tjampijinpa;
- (c) Porky Darkie, Mirlkiya and Patarrs;
- (d) Katangiinyi;

- 12. The nature and extent of the native title rights and interests held by the native title claim group in the whole of the application area (including any areas where extinguishment must be disregarded pursuant to sections 47, 47A and 47B of the NTA) is the right to possess, occupy, use and enjoy the land and waters of the application area to the exclusion of all others.
- 13. The native title rights and interests are:

- (b) subject to the valid laws of the State of Western Australia and the Commonwealth of Australia, including the common law.

- (b) Category B intermediate period acts that are wholly inconsistent with the continued existence, enjoyment or exercise of any native title rights or interests;
- (c) any area in relation to which a 'relevant act' as that term is defined in section 12I of the *Titles (Validation)* and *Native Title (Effect of Past Acts)* Act 1995 (WA) was done and the act is attributable to the State of Western Australia:
- (d) any area in relation to which a previous exclusive possession act under section 12J of the *Titles (Validation and Native Title (effect of Past Acts) Act 1995* (WA) was done and that act is attributable to the State of Western Australia;
- (e) any area in relation to which a previous exclusive possession act as defined by section 23B (including section 23B(7)) of the NTA was done in relation to the area and the act was attributable to the Commonwealth; and (f) any areas where native title rights and interests have otherwise been wholly extinguished.
