WAD483/2018 Palyku #2 (WC2018/022) - Remaining application area

This description is an interpretation of the application area that remains undetermined following the determination of native title by the Federal Court of Australia on 6 September 2021 for part of Palyku #2 WAD483/2018 (WCD2021/006).

External boundary description

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The remaining application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at a point on the southern boundary of Native Title Determination WAD20/2019 Nyamal People #1 (WCD2019/010), being the easternmost north eastern corner of Native Title Determination WAD23/2019 Palyku Part A (WCD2019/002) and extending generally westerly and generally north westerly along the northern boundary of that determination to a north eastern corner at Longitude 120.237308° East; then generally north westerly passing through the following coordinate points:

Then north westerly to a northern corner of Native Title Determination WAD23/2019 Palyku Part A (WCD2019/002) at Longitude 120.052088° East, Latitude 21.848444° South; then north westerly to a north eastern corner of again Native Title Determination WAD23/2019 Palyku Part A (WCD2019/002) at Longitude 119.503750° East, Latitude 21.745504° South; then generally north westerly along the boundary of that determination to the south easternmost corner of the north-westernmost severance of Native Title Determination WAD23/2019, WAD483/2018 Palyku and Palyku #2 (WCD2021/003); then generally north westerly along the boundary of that severance to a southern corner of Native Title Determination WAD20/2019 Nyamal People #1 (WCD2019/010) at approximate Longitude 119.177269° East, Latitude 21.507206° South; then generally north easterly and generally south easterly along the boundary of that determination back to the commencement point.

For the avoidance of doubt the application excludes any land and waters already claimed by:

- Native Title Determination WAD23/2019 Palyku Part A (WCD2019/002) as determined by the Federal Court on 12 March 2019.
- Native Title Determination WAD20/2019 Nyamal People #1 (WCD2019/010) as determined by the Federal Court on 24 September 2019.

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- Native Title Determination WAD23/2019, WAD483/2018 Palyku and Palyku #2
 (WCD2021/003) as determined by the Federal Court on 10 March 2021.
- Native Title Determination WAD483/2018 Palyku #2 (WCD2021/006) as determined by the Federal Court on 6 September 2021.
