



First Nations of the South East No.1

External boundary description

The application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Parcel ID H401100 S5 (Ngarkat Conservation Park), being a point on the South Australian / Victorian State Border and extending southerly along that State Border to a point 500 metres seaward of the Mean Low Water Mark of the coastline; then generally westerly and generally north westerly along that 500 metre buffer from the Mean Low Water Mark to the intersection of the prolongation west of the northern boundary of Parcel ID D31585 A7; then easterly along that prolongation to the Mean Low Water Mark being a point on the boundary of native title determination application SAD180/2017 First Nations of the South East No.2 (SC2017/001) and SAD6027/1998 Ngarrindjeri and Others Native Title Claim (SC1998/004); then generally south easterly and generally northerly along the boundary of those native title determination applications further described as:

Then generally south easterly along the Mean Low Water Mark, across the mouths of any waterways flowing into the Southern Ocean between the seaward extremities at Low Water Mark of each of the opposite banks of each such waterway to the intersection with a line joining Longitude 139.824546° East, Latitude 36.668962° South and Longitude 139.962572° East, Latitude 36.625652° South (in the vicinity of The Granites); then generally north easterly and generally north westerly through the following coordinate points:

Then north westerly to the intersection of the centreline of Woods Well Road and a line joining Longitude 140.117230° East, Latitude 36.021610° South and the intersection of the southern boundary of Dukes Highway at Longitude 140.022289° East, south west of Tintinara.

Then generally north easterly, generally north westerly and north easterly along the centrelines of Woods Well Road, Northcott Terrace and Fulwood Avenue to the centreline of the Dukes Highway; then generally south easterly along the centreline of that Highway to the centreline of Snoswell Road; then north easterly and northerly along that centreline to the prolongation west of the southern boundary of Parcel ID H400100 S7 (Ngarkat Conservation Park); then generally easterly along that prolongation and the southern boundaries of Ngarkat Conservation Park back to the commencement point.
