## Statements of the kind mentioned in ss. 24EB(1) or 24EBA(1) or (4)

For the purposes of s.24EB(1)(b) and s.24EBA(1)(a)(ii) of the NTA, and Regulation 8(4) of the Native Title (Indigenous Land Use Agreements) Regulations 1999, the Dja Dja Wurrung Native Title Group and the Proponent each consent to the doing of, and the validating of, each of the Future Acts and agrees not to challenge their validity at any time in the future.

### The Future Acts

In this Agreement, unless the contrary intention appears, the “Future Acts” means the grant of the Mining Licence in accordance with the MRDA (Mineral Resources Development Act 1990 (Vic)) to enable the Proponent to undertake mining activities by itself or through its contractors relating to or incidental to the activities authorised or conducted under the Mining Licence “the Project”, and any act necessary to enable the Project to proceed in accordance with all Applicable Laws, including without limitation, the approvals referred to in Recital D, any supplementary or

ancillary acts necessary or desirable to maintain the structures and works comprising the Project.

The parties agree that the 'right to negotiate' provisions in Subdivision P of the Native Title Act 1993 are not intended to apply to this agreement.
