## Description of the area covered by the agreement

The ILUA area covers land and waters within the external boundary of the native title application V6005/00 Wamba Wamba, Barapa Barapa, Wadi Wadi Peoples (VC00/5), but excludes any Crown Land that is overlapped by any other current native title determination application made by another claim group (as defined in section 253 of the Native Title Act 1993) as at the time of registration of this ILUA. The ILUA Area also excludes the lands and waters of VG6001/95 Yorta Yorta Clans (VC94/1) as determined by the Federal Court on 18/12/1998.

The external boundary of native title determination application V6005/00 Wamba Wamba, Barapa Barapa & Wadi Wadi Peoples (VC00/5) is described as follows:

Commencing on the Victoria/New South Wales Border at Longitude 143.212854 East, Latitude 34.731301 South and extending south westerly, generally southerly and easterly through the following coordinate points:

Point Longitude East (Decimal Degrees) Latitude South (Decimal Degrees)

- 1 142.808439 35.285354
- 2 142.846441 35.449733
- 3 142.957088 36.260624
- 4 144.298996 35.964845

Then north easterly to the Victoria/New South Wales Border at Longitude 144.361667 East, 35.797783 South; then generally north westerly along that border back to the commencement point.

Clause 6.2 states that the ILUA takes effect from the day it is executed by all Parties and will terminate:

- subject to sub-clause 6.2.2, by the agreement in writing of the Native Title Signatories and MCA; or
- by the removal of the ILUA from the Register of Indigenous Land Use Agreements under section 199C of the NTA; or
- 5 years from the anniversary date of the expiry of the last Exploration Licence granted subject to the provisions of the ILUA.

## Statements of the kind mentioned in ss. 24EB(1) or 24EBA(1) or (4)

7.1 The Parties agree that the right to negotiate provisions in Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision P of the NTA [Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)] are not intended to apply to the grant and use of the Exploration Licence.

7.2 Subject to compliance by the Parties with the provisions of the ILUA and compliance by the Explorer with a Deed, the Parties agree to the doing of certain Future Acts in respect of the ILUA area, being:

7.2.1 the grant by the State of the Exploration Licence to the Explorer and to any consent required by or on behalf of the Explorer pursuant to the Exploration Licence; and

7.2.2 the use of the Exploration Licence and of any consent required pursuant to the Exploration Licence, by the Explorer.

Definitions:

“Exploration Licence” means the exploration licence, that is applied for by the Explorer and may be granted and registered by the State pursuant to the MRDA, which Exploration Licence is located wholly or partly within the ILUA area, and includes any renewal, amalgamation or variation of the exploration licence by the State pursuant to the MRDA or any other applicable laws. “Exploration Licence” also includes any other application for and grant of any other exploration licence to the Explorer during the term of the ILUA in respect of the ILUA area, that is included in a Deed.

“Future Act” has the same meaning given to that term in section 233 of the NTA.
