Statements of the kind mentioned in ss. 24EB(1) or 24EBA(1) or (4)

Clause 7.2

Gunditj Mirring hereby consents, and for the purposes of s24EB(1)(b) of the NTA states that it consents, to the grant to Gunditj Mirring of Crown land in fee simple of the Lake Condah Area by private treaty.

Clause 7.3

The Parties intend, and for the purposes of s24EB(1)(c) state that they intend, that Subdivision P of Division 3 of

Part 2 of the NTA (which deals with the right to negotiate) is not to apply to the transfer to Gunditj Mirring of Crown land in fee simple of the Lake Condah Area by private treaty.

Clause 10.1

The Parties agree, and for the purposes of s24EBA(1)(a) and (b) of the NTA state that they agree, to the validating of future acts (other than an intermediate period act) of all classes which:

- (a) have already been done in relation to any land and waters in the ILUA Area on or prior to the date of registration of this Agreement;
- (b) are attributable to the State; and
- (c) were invalid because of the provisions of the NTA.

Clause 1 Interpretation includes the following definitions:

Lake Condah Area means the area which is the subject of the Contract of Sale of Crown Land in Fee Simple by Private Treaty described in Schedule 1 of this Agreement and depicted on the plan provided in Schedule 4 of this Agreement. The Lake Condah Area comprises CA 1 of 14 in the Parishes of Dunmore and Condah; CA 70C in the Parish of Dunmore; and CA 4F of 5 in the Parish of Condah.

NTA means the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth)
