Description of the area covered by the agreement

The agreement area is described and mapped in Schedule A of the Deed of Amendment of Indigenous Land Use Agreement. A copy of Schedule A is attached to this register extract.

The following general description of the agreement area has been provided by the National Native Title Tribunal to assist people to understand the location of the agreement area. It is provided for information only and should not be considered part of the Register of ILUAs:

The agreement area is a 25 metres wide corridor covering about 2.5 square kilometres, extending south-east for about 100 kilometres from a point on the Shaw River 32 kilometres north of the town of Port Fairy. The agreement area falls within the Local Government Authority of the Corangamite and Moyne Shire Councils.

Clause 4 Term

4.1 This Agreement commences on the date the last party to this Agreement executes and dates this Agreement.

4.2 Subject to any provision in this Agreement to the contrary, this Agreement shall terminate 20 years after the date of the registration of this Agreement.

For the purposes of s. 24EB(1)(b) and s. 24EBA(1)(a)(ii) [...] [the parties] consent to the doing of, and the validating of, each of the Future Acts [...].

'Future Acts' are defined as 'everything necessary or expedient to give effect to the Project [being to construct, install, operate, maintain, repair, replace and further develop a gas transmission pipeline from Port Campbell in Victoria to Torrens Island in South Australia]', and any act necessary to enable the Project to proceed in accordance with all applicable laws [...]
