Statements of the kind mentioned in ss. 24EB(1) or 24EBA(1) or (4)

The agreement contains the following statements:

Clause 11: Upon execution of this Agreement, the State will take steps to revoke the temporary reservation over the Birchip Police Station site, and cause it to be granted to the East Wimmera Health Service as unencumbered fee simple title under s.99A of the Land Act 1958.

Clause 11.1: The parties acknowledge that the process in clause 11 involves a number of steps which will take several months to complete.

Clause 12: To the extent to which the activities in clause 11 may constitute a future act under the Native Title Act (cth) 1993 (NTA), the native title group consents to the doing of those future acts.

Clause 12.1 To the extent to which it might constitute a future act, the native title group also consents to the construction of a new clinic by the East Wimmera Health Service on the Birchip Police Station site.

Clause 14: Upon execution of this Agreement, the native title group surrenders any native title rights and interests which they may hold over Crown Allotment 6, the Birchip Police Station site. This surrender is intended to extinguish any of the their existing native title rights and interests over that site.
