Consent to Acts

The Commonwealth wants to use the extension area for defence purposes.

For the purposes of section 24EB of the Native Title Act 1993 the parties consent to:

1. the revocation by the State of Queensland of Pasturage Reserve 129 as set apart in the Government Gazette on 8 June 1869, over the extension area;

2. the grant to the Commonwealth [defined in the agreement to mean 'the grant by the State of Queensland to the Commonwealth of freehold title to the extension area, or a perpetual or term lease for defence and related purposes over the extension area'];

3. the grant by the Commonwealth of the Licence.

["Extension Area" being Lot 1 on SP150806]

The "right to negotiate" provisions in Subdivision P of Division 3 of the Native Title Act 1993 are not intended to and do not apply to the grant to the Commonwealth.
