## Description of the area covered by the agreement

The Agreement area is approximately 39 square kms and corresponds to EPM14422 which is described as Graticular Blocks:  
NORM 3051 sub-block Z  
NORM 3052 sub-block V  
NORM 3123 sub-blocks P, T, U, Y and Z  
NORM 3124 sub-blocks A, B, F, L and Q  
(as defined on the Normanton Graticular Index Map).  
The Agreement area is located approximately 142 km northeast of Mount Isa and falls within the Cloncurry Shire Council local government area.

The Agreement commenced on 27 July 2004 and will continue until the end of the term of the Exploration Permit (which is defined to include any renewal or extensions to the permit)

## Statements of the kind mentioned in ss. 24EB(1) or 24EBA(1) or (4)

Clause 5.1 The Parties state:-

(a) this Agreement is an Indigenous Land Use Agreement (Area Agreement) within the meaning of Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision C of the Native Title Act because it is about the doing within an area, subject to conditions, of future acts included in classes without the right to negotiate applying to the doing of those future acts. This Agreement

contains the consent of the Parties to the doing of such acts;

(d) the Exploration Permit which is granted, or exploration which is done on the Exploration Permit area, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, will be valid under the Native Title Act;

(e) this Agreement applies to the classes of future acts referred to in Clause 5.2; and

(f) the right to negotiate procedure is not intended to, and does not, apply to Future Acts in the classes referred to in Clause 5.2.

Clause 5.2 This Agreement (and the benefits and obligations of this Agreement) applies to the Exploration Permit.

Clause 5.3 By entering into this Agreement, the registered native title claimants and Native Title Party and the Explorer jointly and severally consent to the grant of the Exploration Permit (including any renewals etc as defined).

Clause 1.1 Definitions

"Exploration Permit" means EPM14422 and any renewal of EPM14422 or any exploration permit in replacement of EPM 14422 and any renewal of such exploration permit.

"Native Title Party" means the Registered Native Title Claimants for themselves and for the native title claim group named in native title claim QC99/32.

"Explorer" means William Croydon Pty Ltd ACN 080 014 160 and its successors and assigns.
