

WAD21/2019 Mullewa Wadjari Community (WC1996/093) – Remaining application area

This description is an interpretation of the Part B of WAD21/2019 Mullewa Wadjari Community (WC1996/093) application area that remains undetermined following the consolidation of Part A of WAD21/2019 Mullewa Wadjari Community (WC1996/093) and determination of native title by the Federal Court of Australia on 7 February 2020 for WAD21/2019, WAD31/2019, WAD27/2019, WAD19/2019, WAD345/2019 Yamatji Nation (WCD2020/001).

External boundary description

The remaining application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at the intersection of a northern boundary of Native Title Determination WAD21/2019, WAD31/2019, WAD27/2019, WAD19/2019, WAD345/2019 Yamatji Nation (WC2020/001) with the southernmost point on the external boundary of Native Title Determination WAD6136/1998, WAD286/2018 Nanda People and Nanda #2 (WC2018/011) and extending generally north easterly and generally easterly along the eastern external boundary of that latter native title determination to Longitude 115.196303° East; then generally north easterly passing through the following coordinate points:

Then again north easterly to intersect the eastern external boundary of again Native Title Determination WAD6136/1998, WAD286/2018 Nanda People and Nanda #2 (WC2018/011) at Longitude 115.202021° East and extending generally north easterly and generally easterly along the boundary of that native title determination to Longitude 115.206558° East; then generally easterly and generally north easterly passing through the following coordinate points:

Then north westerly to again intersect the eastern external boundary of Native Title Determination WAD6136/1998, WAD286/2018 Nanda People and Nanda #2 (WC2018/011) at Latitude 27.529205°

South and extending generally north westerly and generally north easterly along the boundary of that native title determination to intersect the western boundary of Native Title Determination WAD6033/1998 Wajarri Yamatji (WCD2017/007); then generally north easterly and generally south easterly along the southern external boundary of that native title determination to a south western corner at approximate Longitude 116.654171° East, Latitude 28.046707° South; then south easterly to Longitude 116.656705° East, Latitude 28.054638° South; then southerly towards Longitude 116.684049° East, Latitude 28.337313° South until the intersection with the northern external boundary of Native Title Determination WAD21/2019, WAD31/2019, WAD27/2019, WAD19/2019, WAD345/2019 Yamatji Nation (WC2020/001); then generally north westerly along the northern external boundary of that native title determination back to the commencement point.

For the avoidance of doubt the application excludes any land and waters already claimed by:

- Native Title Determination WAD6033/1998 Wajarri Yamatji (WCD2017/007) as determined by the Federal Court on 19 October 2017.
- Native Title Determination WAD6136/1998, WAD286/2018 Nanda People and Nanda #2 (WC2018/011) as determined by the Federal Court on 28 November 2018.
- Native Title Determination WAD21/2019, WAD31/2019, WAD27/2019, WAD19/2019, WAD345/2019 Yamatji Nation (WC2020/001) as determined by the Federal Court on 7 February 2020.

Reference datum
