



Gurambilbarra Wulgurukaba People

External boundary description

The application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at the intersection of the line joining the seaward extremities at High Water Mark of the opposite banks of Rollingstone Creek and its centreline and extending generally south easterly along the High Water Mark to the centreline of Ross River; then generally south westerly along that centreline to the centreline of Central Creek; then southerly and westerly passing through Longitude 146.701885° East, Latitude 19.551256° South to the peak of Pepper Pot Mountain; then south westerly to a point on the south western boundary of the Ross River Sub Drainage Basin at Latitude 19.571006° South; then generally north westerly along the boundaries of that Sub Drainage Basin and the Black River Sub Drainage Basin to a point on the northern boundary of Lot A on WG318 at Longitude 146.371809° East (being a point on the southern boundary of native title determination application QUD148/2015 Nywaigi People (QC2015/003)); then generally northerly passing through the following peaks:

Then north easterly to the centreline of Rollingstone Creek at Latitude 19.057024° South; then generally northerly along that centreline back to the commencement point.

The application area also includes all land and waters above High Water Mark covering the following islands:

- Rattlesnake Island
- Herald Island



The application area specifically excludes all of the land and waters subject to:

- QUD148/2015 Nywaigi People (QC2015/003) as accepted for registration 5th June 2015.

Reference datum
