

Cairns Regional Claim No. 1

The application area covers all the land and waters within the external boundary described as:

Commencing at the intersection of the centrelines of the Barron River and Freshwater Creek and extending generally easterly and generally southerly along the centreline of that creek to Latitude 16.979350° South; then south to the foreshore of Lake Morris at Latitude 16.981379° South, being the boundary of Lot 50 on NR6547; then generally south-westerly and generally easterly along that foreshore to Longitude 145.660676° East at Latitude 16.990546° South; then generally south-westerly passing through the following coordinate points:

Then northerly to the centreline of the Mowbray River at Latitude 16.570169° South; then generally north easterly along the centreline of that river to its intersection with the line between the seaward extremities at High Water Mark of each of its opposite banks; then generally south easterly, generally easterly and again generally south easterly along that High Water Mark, across the mouths of any waterways flowing into the Coral Sea between the seaward extremities at High Water Mark of each of the opposite banks of each such waterway, to Lot 105 on AP7001; then generally south westerly along that boundary and northern and western boundaries of Lot4 on RP749342 to Latitude 16.820920° South; then westerly to a northeast corner of Lot 60 on RP835486; then westerly and generally northerly along the eastern boundaries of that lot, Lot 3 on USL9661, Lot 34 on SP113641, Lot 234 on SP122860, and again Lot 34 on SP113641 to Lot 50 on USL9567; then generally northerly and generally southerly along boundaries of that lot to it's southwest corner; then north westerly, across Half Moon Creek, to the southernmost corner of Lot3 on RP745338; then north westerly and generally south westerly along the boundaries of Lot 27 on AP13734 to the westernmost corner of that lot; then generally southerly, generally easterly, again generally southerly and again generally easterly along the western and southern boundaries of Lot 2 on USL9661, Lot 3 on USL9661, Lot 217 on CP867126 and Lot 60 on RP835486 to that lot's southernmost corner; then south easterly to the easternmost corner of Lot 126 on NR5009; then southerly along the western boundaries of that lot and Lot 3 on RP713690 and onwards to the intersection of the southern boundaries of Yorkeys Knob Road and Morabito Road; then generally south westerly along the southern boundary of Yorkeys Knob Road to the northwest corner of Lot 60 on NR6164; then easterly,

northerly, generally easterly and generally southerly along the northern boundaries of that low and Lot 2 on RP724775 and eastern boundaries of Lot 1 on RP894172 and Lot 1 on RP708705 to the northern bank of Thomatis Creek; then generally north easterly along that bank and northern bank of Richters Creek to the mouth of that creek at High Water Mark; then generally south easterly along that High Water Mark, across the mouths of any waterways flowing into the Coral Sea between the seaward extremities at High Water Mark of each of the opposite banks of each such waterway centreline of the Barron River; then generally westerly along that centreline back to the commencement point.

Exclusions

The application area excludes any areas subject to:

- The area known as Mona Mona, specifically:
 - The Cultural Reserve, Lot 33 on NR5055;
 - The Cemetery Reserve, Lot 36 on NR5287;
 - The Aboriginal Reserve, Lot 25 on N157416; and
 - Any roads internal to the outer boundary of these lots.
- Lot 469 on NR5837, being the area covered by Djabugay-Bulway--Yirrgay-Nyakali-Guluy People QUD 398/2015 and the Arcella Family Investments Pty Ltd Non Claimant application
- Native title determination QUD6002/1998 Djabugay People (QCD2004/011) as determined on 17 December 2004
- Native title determination QUD208/2004 Tableland Yidinji People #3 (QCD2013/001) as determined on 26 March 2013
- Native title determination QUD6030/1999 Tableland Yidinji People (QCD2012/014) as determined on 14 December 2012
- Native title determination application QUD631/2012 Gimuy Walubara Yidinji People (QC2012/017) as accepted for registration on 20 December 2012
