### Persons claiming to hold native title:

1. The native title claim group ("the claimants") in relation to the area claimed is comprised of the Primary Native Title Holders and Other Native Title Holders who, according to traditional laws acknowledged, and customs observed:

(a) are traditionally connected with the area described in schedule B "the area claimed") by reason of:

i. patrilineal descent;

ii. his or her mother, father's mother or mother's mother being or having been a member of the group by reason of patrilineal descent;

iii. having been adopted or incorporated into the descent relationships referred to in (a) or (b) hereof;

(b) have a communal native title in the application area, from which rights and interests derive.

2. The Primary Native Title Holders by definition in relation to the area claimed are comprised of nine estate groups:

(a) the Ngapurr - Pinkakujarra group;

(b) the Narrwan group;

(c) the Walanypirri group;

(d) the Yingawunarri Group;

(e) the Purrurruka Group;

(f) the Yilyiyimarri Group;

(g) the Japuwuny-Wijina Group;

(h) the Billinara Group;

(i) the Wampana Group.

By definition, the Ngapurr - Pinkakujarra estate group is comprised of all persons descended from one apical person being the late Charlie Mulyungkari.

The descendants from Charlie Mulyungkari include:

(a) Jimmy Wavehill Ngawanja who is an Aboriginal man whose children include Derek Jimmy, Patrick Jimmy, Phillip Jimmy, Warren Jimmy, Colin Jimmy, Carol Jimmy, Kirsten Jimmy, Caroline Jimmy, Kerry Jimmy and Damuel Jimmy;

(b) Dotty Juwalngali (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman whose children include Leslie Maroney Naparrkari, George Maroney (Jnr) Nupujuman, Kevin Maroney Talungka, Daphney Maroney, Maxie Maroney, Billy Maroney (adopted) and Allan Maroney (adopted).

By definition, the estate group Narrwan, is comprised of all persons descended from one apical person being the late Number-one-warra.

The descendants from Number-one-warra include:

(a) Eric Maraljinga Jalyirri (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Junior Berd and Angela.

By definition, the estate group Walanypirri, is comprised of all persons descended from one apical person being the late Old Paddy Langajarlwari.

The descendants from Old Paddy Langajarlwari include:

(a) Peter Mangurru (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;

(b) Paddy Horsetailer Henderson Malujarri (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Sally Henderson, Paul Henderson, Peter Henderson and Elizabeth Henderson;

(c) Pampurrkunanya (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Dick Kingston (deceased), B/Jessie Ngilili (deceased) and Jack Scoba Parrjikala (deceased);

(d) Ned Wulayabikari (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Lindsay Bostock Naliwankari.

By definition, the estate group Yingawunarri is comprised of all persons descended from three apical persons who were brothers being the late King Nyirtikurkarri, Robin Parranjini and Bungree Yungkupalyi.

The descendants from King Nyirtikurkarri include:

(a) Billy King Yarninyjakarri Jampijina (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Douglas King, Roger King, Brian King, Jill King, Dianne King, Marjory King and Wilfred King;

(b) Young Billy King Lirranginti (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Jack King, George King, Billy King (Jnr), Jerry King, Rosemary King, Joanna King, Johnny King and Jay King (deceased).

The descendants from Robin Parranjini include:

(a) Sambo "Curry" Jilkijkarri (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Horace Julukari, David Tarrayil, Brian Janba, George Nilja, Susan Yirrimili, Grace Ninkarawa and Billy Barambikari 'Wirla';

(b) Albert Crowson Lalka (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;

(c) Tobacco Jack who is an Aboriginal man whose children include Adam;

(d) Roger Jack (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;

(e) Sugarbag Jawiya (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had children;

(f) Donald Harrison Karnaminji (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had three children;

(g) Smiler Marrintikarri (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;

(h) Elsie Parranjinni who is an Aboriginal woman who had no children;

(i) Daisy Parranijinni who is an Aboriginal woman who had no children;

(j) Nancy Parranijinni who is an Aboriginal woman who had no children;

(k) Agnes Parranjinni who is an Aboriginal woman who had no children.

The descendants from Bungree Yungkupalyi include:

(a) Leena Wilirringa Yimawurrngali (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman whose children include Bonnie;

(b) Monday Tungkanyan (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Mickey Carson Jangari and Charlie Warntiuy;

(c) Jatapurrgali (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had children;

(d) Lily Yintalwa (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had children;

(e) Long Captain Marrjala (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose adopted children include Johnny, Susan, Punch, Sandra and Jennifer.

By definition, the Purrurruka estate group is comprised of all persons descended from one apical person being the late Old Kelly Niwu.

The descendants from Old Kelly Niwu include:

(a) Nancy Carson who is an Aboriginal woman who has no children.

By definition, the Yilyiyimarri estate group is comprised of all persons descended from one apical person being a late unnamed Jurlama man.

The descendants of the unnamed Jurlama man include:

(a) Lion Wundamarla (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Doug Campbell (adopted) (deceased);

(b) Tiger Warrnga (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;

(c) Ngawayaya Nimarra (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman whose children include George Parlarrkparri Jimija;

(d) an unnamed Nimarra (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman whose children include Bob Walyawuny Jimija (deceased);

(e) Nellie Namarntal (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman whose children include Dandy Danbayarri;

(f) an unnamed Nimarra (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman who had no children.

By definition, the Japuwuny - Wijina estate group is comprised of all persons descended from two apical persons being two late unnamed Jurlama men.

The descendants of the first unnamed Jurlama man include:

(a) Dunggwarri Tingkankarri Japarta (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Jarlarla Jurlama.

The descendants of the second unnamed Jurlama man include:

(a) Sunlight Yawirdi Japarta (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children;

(b) Starlight Ngimbiyarri Japarta (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Raymond Starlight and Karen Ninypurrngali;

(c) Elsey Japarta (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children.

By definition, the Billinara estate group is comprised by all persons descended from three apical persons who were sisters being the late Lily Jurulngul, Lilly Kapalngal and Minyaminya.

The descendants of Lily Jurulngul include:

(a) Anzac Mungkayi (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Nora Kuwinyukal, Florrie Karawul, Marjorie Ngayangari, Christine Ngayangari, Jackie Jaturin, Billy Wulkuyan, Greenie Kalpiyari, Elmore Tanmiyari, Andrew Tanpiyari, Robert Nimpiyari, Peter Nginiyarri and Nora Marangali;

(b) Hector Warlpinyarri who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Nugget Martukwrrw, Rodney Wamaranyunu, Victor Tutuyari, Bobby Marara; Pieman Wanayari, Tony Yarpuyari, Kenny Marpiyari, Raymond Yunga, Barbara Warnguya, Elizabeth Kinmaya, Melba Jariwankari, Sally Tampa, Mildred Yarpingali, Jenny Nyinankura, Dale Parnayari, Roy Yinmayari, Russell Lirrpngayari, Sheila Marpingali, Nina Yawurngali and Eunice Wirringali.

The descendants of Lilly Kapalngali include:

(a) Jack Gallagher (Calico) (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man who had no children.

The descendants of Minyaminya include:

(a) a daughter whose name is unknown (deceased) whose children include Ivy Kulngari (deceased).

By definition, the Wampana estate group is comprised by all persons descended from two apical persons who were brothers being the late Alligator Tommy Jampiyin and Joe Lingari Jampiyin.

The descendants from Alligator Tommy Jampiyin include:

(a) Lena Nangala (deceased) who was an Aboriginal woman whose children include Elsey Nalyirri (deceased), Pansy Nalyirri, Tamarine Nalyirri, Susan Nalyirri, Marian Nalyirri, Harry Nalyirri and Sammy Nalyirri;

(b) Hobbles Jangala (deceased) who was an Aboriginal man whose children include Theresa Nanfiyin;

(c) Dora Nangala who is an Aboriginal woman whose children include Smiler George Jalyirri (deceased), Maryanne George Nalyirri, Frankie George Jalyirri (deceased) and Duncan George Jalyirri.

The descendants from Joe Lingari Jampiyin include:

(a) Kevin Kimintiwarra Jangala who is an Aboriginal man;

(b) Connie Nangala who is an Aboriginal woman.

### 3. Other Native Title Holders

In accordance with traditional laws and customs, other Aboriginal people have rights and interests in respect of the determination area, subject to the rights and interests of the estate group members, such people being:

(a) members of estate groups from neighbouring estates;

(b) spouses of the estate group members.

#### **Native title rights and interests claimed:**

1. The claimants are entitled, under traditional laws acknowledged and customs observed, to exercise native title rights and interests in relation to the area claimed which include as follows:

(a) to possess, occupy, use and enjoy the area claimed to the exclusion of all others;

(b) to speak for and to make decisions about the use and enjoyment of the application area;

(c) to reside upon and otherwise to have access to and within the application area;

(d) to control the access of others to the application area;

(e) to use and enjoy the resources of the application area;

(f) to control the use and enjoyment of others of the resources of the application area;

(g) to share, exchange and/or trade resources derived on and from the application area;

(h) to maintain and protect places of importance under traditional laws, customs and practices in the application area;

(i) to maintain, protect, prevent the misuse of and transmit to others their cultural knowledge, customs and practices associated with the application area;

(j) to determine and regulate membership of, and recruitment to, the landholding group.

2. The claimants acknowledge that:

(a) their native title rights and interests are subject to all valid and current laws of the Commonwealth and the Northern Territory; and

(b) the exercise of their native title rights and interests might be regulated, controlled, curtailed, restricted, suspended or postponed by reason of the existence of valid concurrent rights and interests in others by or under such laws.

3. Subject to schedule L, this application does not claim that the native title rights and interests confer possession, occupation, use and enjoyment to the exclusion of all others in relation to any area regarding which a previous non-exclusive possession act under s 23F of the NTA has been done.

4. All rights and interests listed in paragraph 1 above exist (and existed) throughout the whole of the area claimed.

5. The native title rights and interests are held communally by the claimants, albeit that:

(a) the capacity of individuals to exercise these rights and interests will vary according to a variety of circumstances, for example age, gender, and physical and mental capacity;

(b) by traditional laws and customs, responsibility for the area claimed is exercised by different individuals in different ways.

6. The activities referred to in schedule G are enjoyed by the claimants, and derive from their native title and are consistent with their native title rights and interests.

The claimants do not claim ownership of minerals, petroleum or gas wholly owned by the Crown. The claimants assert that the Crown does not wholly own minerals, petroleum or gas in the area subject to the application.

(c) Northern Territory Portion 3531;

(f) Northern Territory Portion 3736 - part designated as Northern Territory Portion 4853(A).

(b) Any areas within those boundaries that are not covered by the Application
