Persons claiming to hold native title:

The native title claim group comprises the Kallardoo (also recorded as Kalaako or Karlaku) Bindi / Bindy descendants. The Kallardoo (also recorded as Kalaako or Karlaku) Bindi / Bindy descendants are the biological descendants, including descendants by adoption recognised under traditional laws and customs, of Bindi (also recorded as Bindy), a Kallardoo apical ancestor, being an Aboriginal person who, under the traditional laws and customs acknowledged and observed by the group, held native title rights and interests in the claim area at the

time of sovereignty. Kallardoo is the name of the tribe. Kalaako and Karlaku are alternative spellings and linguistic recordings referring to the same Kallardoo people and lineage, as recognised under the traditional laws and customs acknowledged and observed by the native title claim group and reflected in historical, anthropological and archival records. Membership of the native title claim group is determined in accordance with the traditional laws and customs acknowledged and observed by the group, including rules relating to descent, kinship, and recognition by the group. A person is a member of the native title claim group if they: • are descended from Bindi / Bindy through biological descent or recognised traditional adoption; and • are recognised as a member of the Kallardoo group under traditional laws and customs.

Native title rights and interests claimed:

Description of the native title rights and interests claimed The Bindi / Bindy Kalaako Kallardoo Karlaku descendants claim the following native title rights and interests in relation to the land and waters covered by the application, possessed under the traditional laws and customs acknowledged and observed by the group. Rights of access, occupation and movement The right to access, enter, move about, camp on, live on, and remain on the land and waters. Rights to use and enjoy natural resources The right to hunt, fish, gather, collect, take and use natural resources of the land and waters, including flora, fauna, water, ochre, timber and other materials, for domestic, cultural, ceremonial, spiritual and medicinal purposes. Cultural and spiritual practices The right to conduct ceremonies, rituals, cultural activities and spiritual practices on the land and waters in accordance with traditional laws and customs. Protection and care of Country The right and responsibility to care for, protect, manage and maintain the land and waters, including culturally significant places, sacred sites, burial places, songlines, rock holes, water sources and other areas of traditional importance. Protection of sites and places of significance The right to access, protect, preserve, maintain and transmit knowledge about sites and places of cultural, spiritual and historical significance. Decision-making and speaking for Country The right, in accordance with traditional laws and customs, to make decisions about the use of the land and waters by members of the native title claim group and to speak for Country in relation to activities affecting the land and waters. Transmission of knowledge The right to teach, share and pass on traditional laws, customs, stories, language, ecological knowledge and cultural practices connected to the land and waters to younger generations. These native title rights and interests are claimed subject to valid extinguishment and to the extent recognised by the common law of Australia.
